

**THE CORPORATION  
OF THE  
MUNICIPALITY OF HURON EAST  
BY-LAW NO. 33 FOR 2006**

Being a by-law to regulate electric personal assistive  
mobility devices within the Municipality of Huron East.

**WHEREAS** subsection 11 (1) 1 of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that a municipality may pass bylaws respecting matters within the sphere of jurisdiction of “Highways, including parking and traffic on highways”;

**AND WHEREAS** subsection 9 (1) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that section 11 shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on municipalities, (a) to enable them to govern their affairs as they consider appropriate; and (b) to enhance their ability to respond to municipal issues;

**AND WHEREAS** subsection 9 (3) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that a by-law under section 11 respecting a matter may (a) regulate or prohibit respecting the matter; and (b) as part of the power to regulate or prohibit respecting the matter, require persons to do things respecting the matter;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Huron East **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

**1. Definition**

“Electric Personal Assistive Mobility Device” means:

- (i) a self-balancing device with two non-tandem wheels, designed to transport only one person, with an electric propulsion system; or
  - (ii) a wheelchair, scooter, or other self-propelled device, powered by an electric propulsion system and designed to transport one person who has a disability.
- 2.** A person may operate an Electric Personal Assistive Mobility Device due to a disability along a sidewalk.
  - 3.** A person may operate an Electric Personal Assistive Mobility Device due to a disability along a bicycle path.
  - 4.** This by-law shall come into force and effect on the day it is passed.

**READ** a first and second time this 16<sup>th</sup> day of May 2006.

**READ** a third time and finally passed this 16<sup>th</sup> day of May 2006.
