

THE CORPORATION
OF THE
MUNICIPALITY OF HURON EAST
BY-LAW NO. 73-2013

Being a by-law to authorize an Agreement for the provisions of landfill services in the Ward of Brussels, at the Morris Ward Landfill Site in the Municipality of Morris-Turnberry, and to repeal By-Laws 74-2001, 64-2006 and 59-2011.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Act, S. O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, s. 20 (1) provides that a municipality may enter into an agreement with one or more municipalities or local bodies, as defined in section 19, or a combination of both to jointly provide for their joint benefit, any matter which all of them have the power to provide within their own boundaries;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Huron East is desirous to enter into an Agreement for the operation and perpetual care of the Morris Ward Landfill Site with the Municipality of Morris-Turnberry for the Brussels Ward;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Huron East **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the Mayor and the CAO/Clerk be and are hereby authorized to sign and execute an Agreement attached hereto as Schedule "A" with the Municipality of Morris-Turnberry to accept waste and share perpetual care costs for the Morris Ward Landfill Site.
2. That By-Law 74-2001, 64-2006 and 59-2011 are hereby repealed.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 1st day of October, 2013.

READ a third time and finally passed this 1st day of October, 2013.
