

THE CORPORATION
OF THE
MUNICIPALITY OF HURON EAST
BY-LAW NO. 92 FOR 2013

Being a by-law to repeal By-Law 48-2010 and to authorize the execution of an agreement to allow the removal of aggregate material from a municipal road allowance in conjunction with abutting licensed gravel pit operations.

WHEREAS Section 11 (2) 4 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 2001, as amended, provides that municipalities may pass by-laws respecting public assets of the municipality acquired for the purpose of exercising its authority;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Huron East under the provisions of By-Law 48-2010 entered into an agreement with owners of licensed gravel pit operations abutting part of the Summerhill Road allowance between Roxboro Line and Division Line to allow for the removal of aggregate materials from said road allowance in conjunction with adjacent gravel pit operations with the term of the agreement to expire on November 30th, 2013;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the corporation of the Municipality of Huron East is desirous of entering into a similar agreement with owners of licensed gravel pit operations abutting part of the Summerhill Road allowance between Roxboro Line and Division Line to allow for the removal of aggregate materials from said road allowance in conjunction with adjacent gravel pit operations with the term of the agreement to expire on November 30th, 2014;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Huron East enacts as follows:

1. That By-Law 48-2010 be repealed effective December 1st, 2013.
2. That the Mayor and CAO/Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and execute an agreement attached hereto as Schedule "A" with the owners of Part Lot 32, Concession 7 (Licence # P853613), Part Lot 33, Concession 7 (Licence # P853515), Part Lots 32 & 33, Concession 6 (Licence # P853449) and Lot 31, Concession 7 (Licence # P853369), all in the former Township of McKillop, now the Corporation of the Municipality of Huron East to allow for the joint removal of aggregate materials from the abutting road allowance (Summerhill Road) as part of adjacent gravel pit operations.
3. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.

Read a first and second time this 19th day of November, 2013.

Read a third time and finally passed this 19th day of November, 2013.
