

**THE CORPORATION
OF THE
MUNICIPALITY OF HURON EAST
BY-LAW NO. 39 FOR 2014**

Being a by-law to authorize an agreement with the Municipality of Morris-Turnberry to provide for an extension of the Brussels Sanitary Sewer System and for the recovery of construction costs thereof.

WHEREAS Section 11 (2) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, as amended, provides that a lower tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters within the spheres of jurisdiction set out therein including, *inter alia*, public utilities;

AND WHEREAS Section 20 (1) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, as amended, enables a municipality to enter into an agreement with one or more municipalities to jointly provide, for their joint benefit, any matter which all of them have the power to provide within their own boundaries;

AND WHEREAS the Councils of the Municipality of Huron East and the Municipality of Morris-Turnberry are desirous of constructing an extension of the Brussels Sanitary Sewer System for the joint benefit of property owners in both Municipalities;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Huron East **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the Deputy Mayor and Deputy Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and execute an agreement, attached hereto as Schedule "A" with the Municipality of Morris-Turnberry for the construction and recovery of costs of an extension to the Brussels Sanitary Sewer System.
2. That pursuant to Section 391 (1) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, as amended, the actual costs for the Huron East share of said sanitary sewer line extension shall be allocated between Huron East property owners in accordance with Schedule "A" attached hereto and shall be recovered from property owners.
3. That all costs allocated to property owners within the Municipality of Huron East for the construction of said sanitary sewer line extension including all connections and appurtenances thereto shall be due upon completion.
4. That any Huron East property owner may request that the Municipality of Huron East carry capital charges and interest until such time as the special assessment is paid to the municipality.
5. That all Huron East properties subject to the special assessment will also be responsible for the connection fee to the Brussels Ward sewer system prevailing at the time of connection or payment.
6. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.

Read a third time and finally passed this 17th day of June, 2014.
