

**THE CORPORATION
OF THE
MUNICIPALITY OF HURON EAST
BY-LAW NO. 13 FOR 2015**

Being a by-law to appoint Brad Dietrich as Chief Building
Official – Pro-Tempore for the Municipality and to repeal By-
Laws 40-2014, 56-2014 and 2-2015.

WHEREAS Section 3 (2) of the Building Code Act, S.O. 1992 c.23, as amended, establishes that the council of each municipality shall appoint a Chief Building Official and such Inspectors as are necessary for the enforcement of this Act in the areas in which the municipality has jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS Section 5 (3) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, as amended, provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of By-Law 44-2001, Paul Josling has been appointed Chief Building Official for the Corporation of the Municipality of Huron East;

AND WHEREAS Chief Building Official Paul Josling is currently on a medical leave of absence effective June 11th, 2014;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Huron East
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Brad Dietrich be appointed as Chief Building Official – Pro-Tempore effective on the date of passing of this by-law.
2. That during the absence of Chief Building Official Paul Josling, Brad Dietrich acting in the capacity of Chief Building Official – Pro-Tempore shall fulfill the obligations of the Municipality of Huron East as required under Section 3 of the Building Code Act, S.O. 1992 c.23.
3. That By-Laws 40-2014, 56-2014 and 2-2015 are hereby repealed.
4. That all other by-laws and/or resolutions which are inconsistent with the provisions herein are hereby repealed.
5. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.

Read a first and second time this 17th day of March, 2015.

Read a third time and finally passed this 17th day of March, 2015.
