BY-LAW NO. 79-2015

Being a by-law to authorize the widening of a municipal highway.

WHEREAS the <u>Municipal Act</u>, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, s. 8 (1) contains broad authority to municipalities to enable municipalities to govern its affairs as it considered appropriate;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of Section 31(2) of the <u>Municipal Act</u>, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, land may only become a highway by virtue of a by-law establishing the highway;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Huron East owns property, more particularly described as Part 4, Plan 22R-6304 which is located adjacent to a municipal road allowance known as Walnut Street, being all of PIN 41345-0092;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Huron East wishes to dedicate and use Part 4, Plan 22R-6304 as a highway;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF HURON EAST ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Part 4, Plan 22R-6304 shall be established as a highway pursuant to the Act.
- 2. That in recognition of the provisions of By-Law 59-2002 of the Corporation of the Municipality of Huron East which changed the name of Walnut Street to Workman Drive, the municipal solicitor is hereby authorized to register By-Law 59-2002 to change Walnut Street to Workman Drive.
- 3. That Part 4, Plan 22R-6304 shall become part of Walnut Street in the Geographic Village of Brussels, Municipality of Huron East.
- 4. The municipal solicitor is hereby authorized and instructed to register a certified copy of this By-Law in the Land Titles Office for the Land Titles Division of Huron.
