## **County Council Report**

## Infrastructure Funding

Councillor Fisher requested consideration be given to preparing a list of projects for the recently announced Federal Budget Infrastructure Funding. Councillor Chartrand also suggested government funding of up to 50% of eligible water and wastewater projects and the potential for sewers in Egmondville and Harpurhey. Mayor MacLellan advised this matter will be discussed at the next Water & Sewer Committee meeting.

#### **Recreation Facilities**

Council discussed various aspects of recreation and the increasing costs to providing recreation services within the Municipality. Council suggested utilizing OMAFRA as a facilitator for Council and the recreation boards/committees to come up with a plan on moving forward. It was noted the recreation committees continue to monitor their budgets and find efficiencies where possible. Deputy Clerk Paula Michiels advised staff is in the process of compiling budgets from area municipalities to provide a comparison/analysis and a report will be coming to Council once municipalities have their budgets set for 2016.

#### 8:22 p.m. Public Meeting – 2016 Budget

Finance Manager-Treasurer/Deputy Clerk Paula Michiels provided a powerpoint presentation consisting of an overview of the entire 2016 budget process. The 3<sup>rd</sup> draft of the 2016 budget recommended an 20.20% increase to the municipal levy. The 2016 budget projects total expenditures of \$14,063,130 including \$3,353,648 in capital expenditures. It was noted that once the General levy, County levy and Education levy are combined, the result would be a 9.71% overall taxation increase for Huron East residents.

*Moved* by Joseph Steffler and seconded by John Lowe: That Council of the Municipality of Huron East adopt the 2016 Budget as presented with projected operation and capital expenditures of \$14,063,130 and staff be directed to prepare a by-law to establish the 2016 tax rates, based on a 20.20% increase in the municipal levy.
