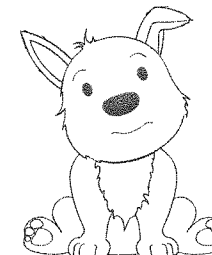

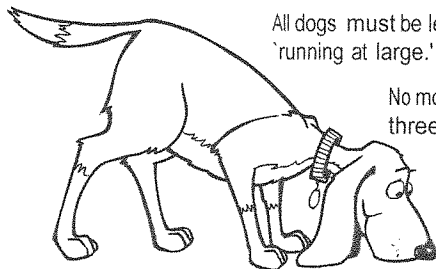

- Every dog owner within the Municipality of Huron East is required to obtain a dog tag annually before February 28th, or within 15 days of becoming a dog owner. Not only does this practice demonstrate responsible pet ownership, it also helps with the identification and safe return of your pet.
- The owner shall keep the tags securely affixed on the dog at all times, until renewed, or replaced.



All dogs must be leashed or under control when not on the owner's property. If a dog strays, it may be impounded at the owner's expense for 'running at large.'

No more than two (2) dogs may be harboured, at any time, in a dwelling unit located within urban areas of the municipality. No more than three (3) dogs may be harboured, at any time, in a dwelling unit located within rural areas of the municipality.

Any dog owner who fails to license their dog(s) in the Municipality of Huron East for the current year is guilty of an offence and, on conviction, is liable to a fine of \$125.00 pursuant of the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, CP. 33, as amended.
