

## The Corporation of the Municipality of Huron East

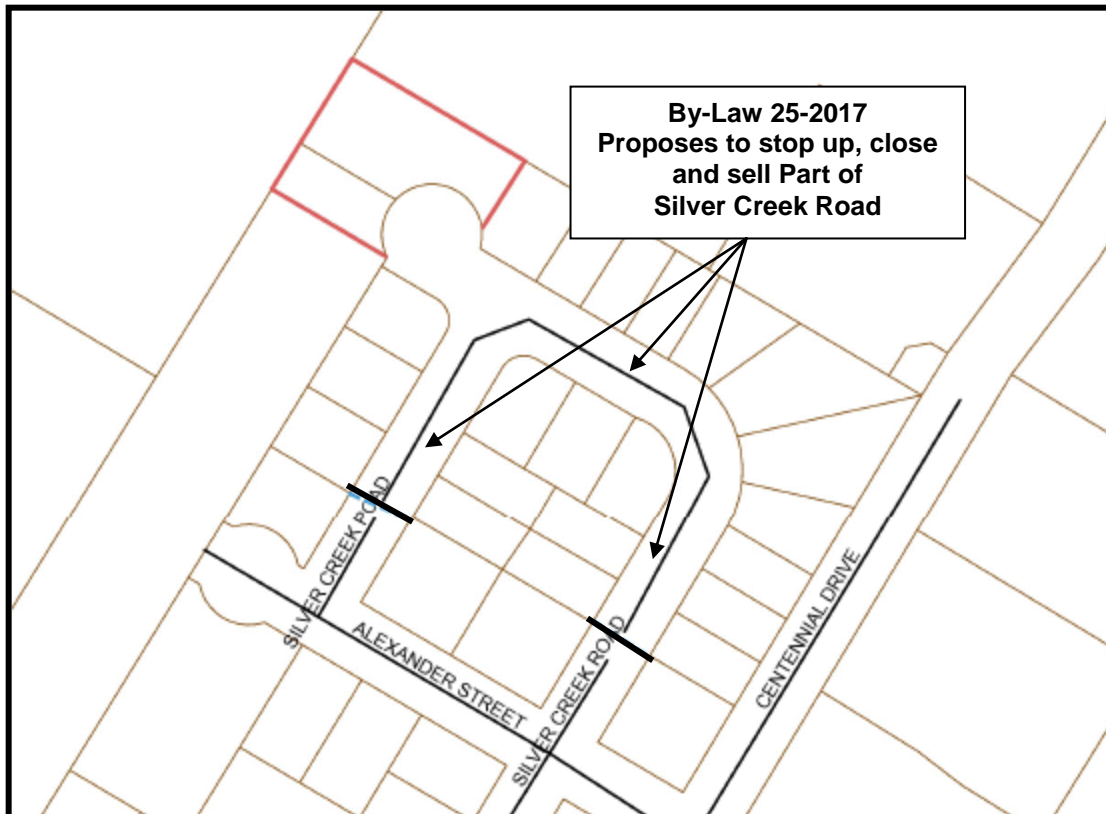

# Explanatory Note to By-Law 25-2017

By-Law 25-2017 proposes to stop-up, close and sell that part of the unopened Silver Creek Road Allowance (Registered Plan 407) as shown on the draft survey below. By-Law 25-2017 proposes to convey the unopened part of the Silver Creek Road Allowance to the owner of the vacant lots in what is commonly known as the "Silvercreek Subdivision". The Municipality does propose to retain an easement on Part 4 which along with an easement on Part 6 will allow for the installation and maintenance of municipal water and sanitary sewer infrastructure.
